The Art Guild of Orange Park, Inc.

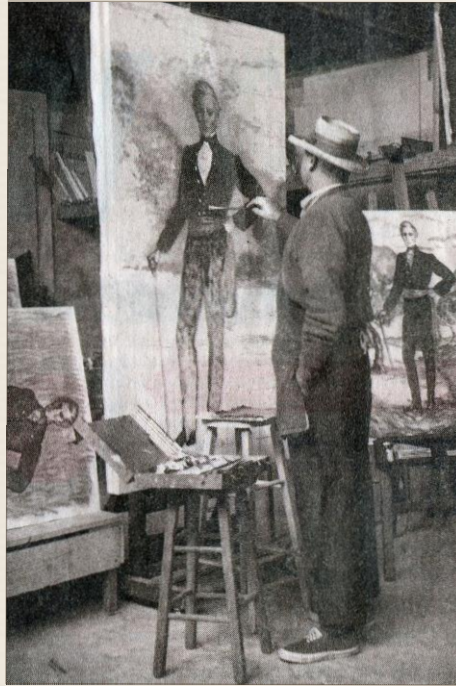

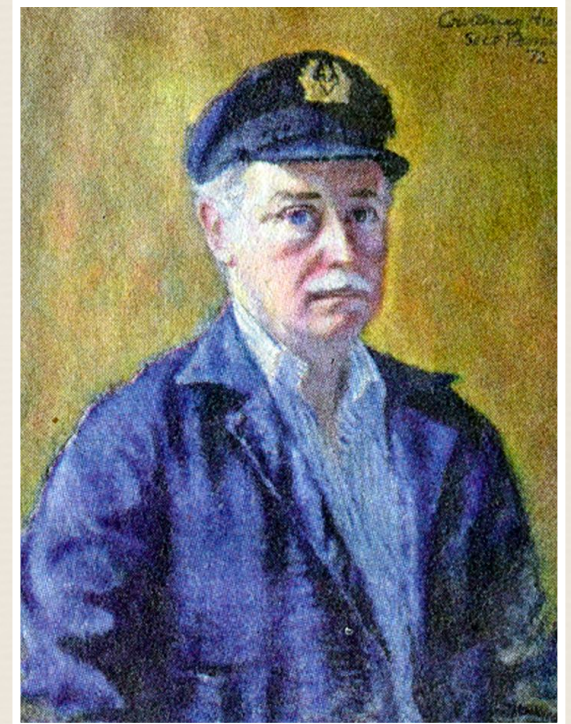

Scholarship Guidelines

All applicants must meet the following mandatory items:

1. Student must be a graduating Senior from a Clay County High School or equivalent home school.
2. Student must be planning to seek a degree in the Visual Fine Arts or Arts Education.
3. Student must complete the Scholarship Application and process.
4. Student must provide a copy of a letter of acceptance from a college or university.
5. Student must provide a letter of recommendation from his or her current art instructor.
6. Must complete ALL of the forms for Student Activities, List of Awards, and GPA as well as to provide their High School transcripts to date.

Students who qualify will be expected to present a portfolio of at least ten of their best works at an interview with the Scholarship Committee. These can represent works from 9th through 12th grades. Be prepared to speak about your art and your artistic ambitions.

Items 3-6 MUST be received before the deadline of:

April 1, 2017

We cannot consider an applicant without these requirements. Interviews will be scheduled after the deadline but before April 15th
