- 5. All Application Forms Completed in Full.

  - C. Student Activities Form
  - D. List of Awards Form
- 6. Portfolio Presentation (Minimum of at least 10 Best Works-Acceptable Collections can include all Grades 9 through 12)
- 7. Scheduled Interview with Scholarship Committee (Individual Preparation for Brief Discussion About Person-al Art Experiences, Created Works, Artistic Ambitions, and Any Other Related Questions is Required).
- 8. Application MUST BE Received Prior to the Deadline of April 1, 2024.
- 9. Interviews will be scheduled after April1st, 2024, but before April 25th, 2024.
